Understanding Your Bill

Patients often ask why they receive several bills for services provided at Malta Med Emergent Care. The answer is that—as at most health care facilities—specialty medical care is usually billed separately. If, for example, you have surgery, the charges for your anesthesia services most likely will not be billed by the hospital. Instead, they will come from your anesthesiologist.

Bills will be sent directly to your insurance company. Even so, we believe it's important for patients to have as much information as possible about our charges and our billing procedures.

Following is a list of practices that provide services at Malta Med Emergent Care. Depending on the type of care you need, you/your insurance company could receive a bill from one or more of these practices. For your convenience, we've organized them by specialty and provided contact information.

Please note: This is not a complete list and, depending on your situation, your doctors may bring in other specialists. To help avoid unexpected charges, ask your doctors if they participate in your insurance and if they will be involving other medical professionals in your care.
